Do you enjoy fixing things and helping others? Are you passionate about sustainability and reducing waste? If so, then volunteering as a fixer at the Slough Repair Café is the perfect opportunity for you!

About the Slough Repair Café:

The Slough Repair Café is a community initiative run by the Slough Anti-Litter Society. We aim to divert broken items from landfill by offering free repairs to residents. We hold our events on the last Saturday of every month, and volunteers are needed to help us fix a variety of items, from clothes and chairs to electrical appliances.

What we expect from Fixers:

Availability: The café is every last Saturday of the month in the Queensmere Shopping centre. Arrive at 10:45 am to help set up and be available to fix items from 11:00 to 14:00. Afterwards we tidy up and are ready to leave around 14:15.

Repair skills: You do not have to be a professional fixer! We are looking for people who have practical skills in fixing items such as small electrical, laptops, textiles and woodwork. But other more bespoke skills, such as jewellery, are also most welcome.

Decision-making: Quickly assess the feasibility of repairing an item and politely decline if necessary.

Teamwork: Collaborate with other volunteers and hosts to ensure a smooth operation.

Communication skills: Explain the repair process to visitors and try to answer their questions as best as you can.
